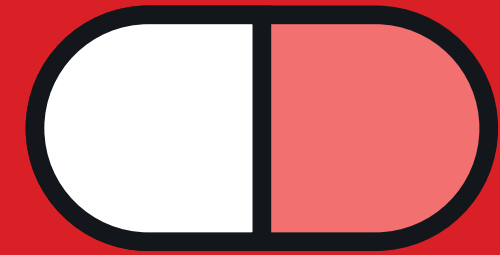

What is HTA?

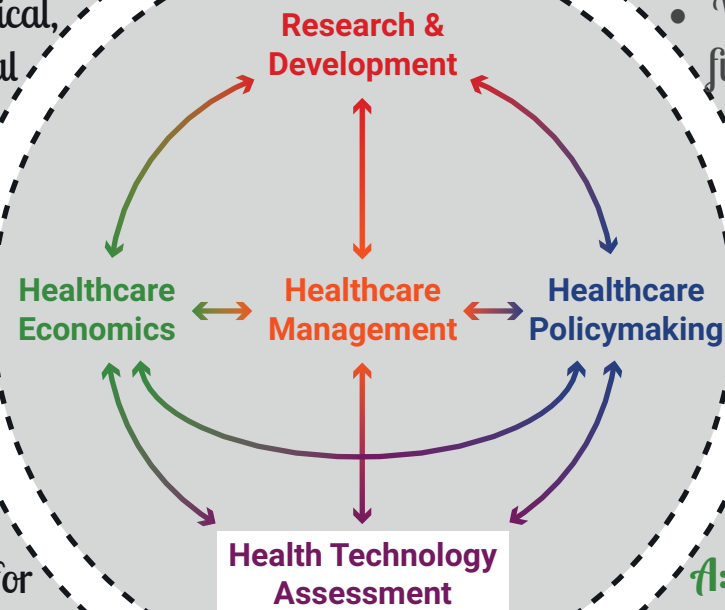
- HTA is “health technology assessment”
- It is “the systematic evaluation of properties, effects, and/or impacts of health technology” by WHO
- HTA considers safety, clinical effectiveness, cost effectiveness as well as ethical, legal and social aspects of health technologies

What we did so far...

- We have assessed the sector requirements and student interests
- We have defined the programme to be a 2-year Master’s programme with a thesis
- We have determined the programme learning outcomes
- We have arranged financial support for fees, substance and travel) for prospective students

What is JoC HTA?

- JoC HTA stands for “Joint Curriculum Development in Health Technology Assessment”
- It is an EU-funded project to create an international postgrad programme in HTA
